1) Usual trade description of the goods, as it is used in the business documents (such as invoices). The declaration can contain a reference to an attachment, for example, "see attached statement".

2) For originating goods in the community, the country of manufacture should always be entered as "European Union" or "EU". The member country (such as Germany or France) can also be entered. If the goods originate in a country with which the EU has made preference agreements (such as Switzerland and so on), then you must enter this country as the originating country.

The assignment to a preference verification (EUR.1, EUR.2 or for the corresponding trade document with declaration of origin) used to import the goods into the EU, and the assignment to the corresponding customs document, are necessary for verification management (such as EUR.1 no. ..., customs document no. ... from ... .. of customs authority). Trade companies must adopt this information, where necessary from the vendor declarations made available to them.

3) It is possible that the originating rules for individual states are different. For this reason, it is always necessary to perform an individual, agreement-based verification check.

If the originating rules valid for the goods exchange in the listed states are not fulfilled, the states must be removed from the list.

4) The European Union (EU) has signed preference agreements with the countries listed on the first page. These agreements guarantee mutual tax concessions. These are called bilateral agreements.

There are certain countries with unilateral agreements. These agreements usually only permit tax concession on imports of goods with preference conditions from the contracted states into the EU. There are agreements for deliveries into certain ACP states (African-Caribbean- Pacific).

If deliveries are bound for countries with which the EU has made unilateral agreements, then in certain circumstances it will be necessary to create preference verifications and to demand vendor declarations. This applies particularly if you are planning to reimport the goods into the EU after they have been processed in an agreement country (for example, after passive processing).

5) The current Long Term Supplier Declaration (LTSD) is created based on information we collected from our suppliers as well as origin determination run against preferential trade agreements rules. Whenever parts are said to be non-preferential, this is due to preferential conditions not being met. Subsequently, and according to the regulations, we will not make further preferential declaration on these given parts.

6) If the business documents and vendor declarations are printed electronically, the declaration does not require a manual signature. However, the responsible person at the vendor must be unambiguously recognizable.


