REACH Annex XVII Restricted substances:

The restricted substances (on their own, in a mixture **or in an article**) are substances for which manufacture, placing on the market or use **is limited or banned in the European Union.**

The article/mixture does not content substances banned in the EU, REACH Annex XVII (**asbestos fibers a.o**)

Limitation for substances listed in REACH ANNEX XVII are not exceeded if used in any materials in the article

Articles in scope for the ROHS regulation do not content hazardous substances above the limits given in the regulation.

EU POP (Persistent Organic Pollutants) regulation:

The restricted substances (on their own, in a mixture **or in an article**) are substances for which manufacture, placing on the market or use **is limited or banned in the European Union.**

The article/mixture does not content substances banned in the EU, POP regulation (**SCCP a.o**)

Minimum presence of hazardous substances

Lead, Cadmium, Mercury and hexavalent Chromium have not been intentionally introduced during the manufacture of the packaging

The sum of the concentration levels of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium present in the packaging materials do not exceed 100 parts per million by weight.
