**Your enquiry concerning the REACH Regulation EC No. 1907/2006 Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation, and restriction of Chemicals.**

Dear Sir, Madam,

The Legrand Group has over many years built up an active policy on Sustainable Development. According to this commitment we take responsibility for the substances, preparations, and articles we use and place on the market. We have consequently considered the REACH obligations and implemented the necessary steps to comply with this regulation.

As a Downstream User, we work in close cooperation with our suppliers to ensure that we use substances and preparations which have been pre-registered and will be registered under REACH in due time.

As a producer of articles, we have the duty to communicate information on the substances<sup>1</sup> present in our articles (REACH – article 33.1<sup>2</sup>).

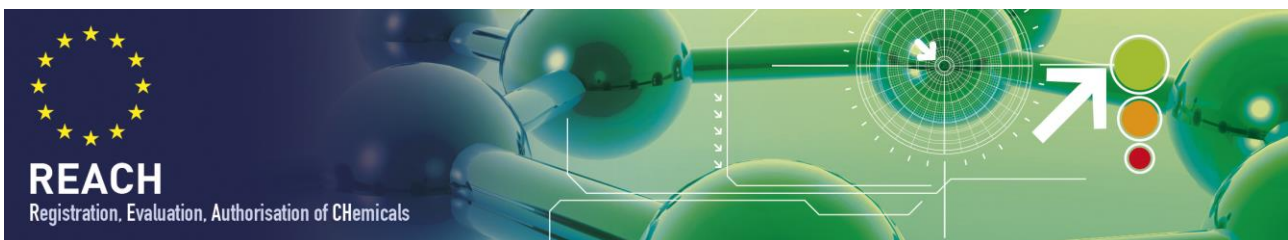
Please note that to our present knowledge, the commercial references mentioned in the list from page 2, do not contain such substances.

<sup>2</sup> Article 33.1: Any supplier of an article containing a substance meeting the criteria in Article 57 and identified in accordance with Article 59(1) in a concentration above 0.1 % weight by weight (w/w) shall provide the recipient of the article with sufficient information, available to the supplier, to allow safe use of the article including, as a minimum, the name of that substance.

Legrand undertakes to update its regulatory data whenever new SVHCs are added to the ECHA candidate list (within a maximum of 6 months as required by the regulation).
